Advent

The word Advent comes from the Latin 'adventus' which means 'arrival' or 'coming'. It is the four weeks before Christmas beginning on November 30 or the nearest Sunday to it. This is the Church's New Year's Day. Advent Sunday, this year, falls on 3rd December. This is the day when the first candle on the advent crown will be lit in church. This first candle is the candle of hope, so prayers on this day focus on hope. The second candle is a symbol of God's peace. Number 3 is the candle of love. The next candle represents joy and the final candle, which is usually white, reminds Christians of the birth of Jesus.



Our Advent Mass on Thursday 30th November will celebrate the beginning of Advent.
