<b>Week</b>	6	<b>From</b>	1.6.2020	<b>To</b>	5.6.2020
<b>Topic Project</b>	Over the next two weeks, I would like to research all of the different types of animals that are often kept as pets. Choose your favourite type of pet and create a poster all about the animal e.g. – what it eats, what type of home/house it lives in, how to look after it etc.				
<b>Subject</b>	<b>Focus</b>	<b>Overview of Home Learning Activities</b>			
<b>Reading</b>	Reading Skills	Read for 10-15 minutes every day – keep a note in your reading record. Use one of the reading resources provided on Wakelet (English) or books you have at home.			
<b>Writing</b>	Phonics	Join in with daily phonics lessons on Ruth Miskin's Read Write Inc. YouTube channel (see link of Wakelet – English). Complete one of the follow-up lessons on Word Reading and/or Spelling. Choose Set 1, 2 or 3 depending on ability and level of challenge.			
	Handwriting	See this week's handwriting sheets on Wakelet (English). One sound per day – this week we are focusing on sh, th, ch, q and ng.			
	Literacy/Writing	Complete this week's lessons and activities all based on 'Animals - Pets' (see daily lessons on Wakelet – Literacy). These will focus on exploring the stories 'I Want A Pet' and 'The Great Pet Sale'. Children will discuss/share ideas, make predictions, compare and contrast, and write words/sentences about different pets.			
<b>Maths</b>	Mental Maths	With a focus on 'Ordering Numbers', spend 10 minutes each day working on a selection of different Mental Maths activities (see Wakelet – Maths).			
	Number or Shape, Space and Measure	Complete this week's lessons and activities all based on 'Counting to 20' (see daily lessons on Wakelet – Maths). Order and recite numbers, match them to quantities and symbols, and build a number staircase showing the pattern to 20.			
<b>RE</b>	Pentecost	Begin to learn about Pentecost, recalling some of the elements of the story of the coming of the Holy Spirit. Complete some of the Pentecost activities provided on Wakelet (Topic and RE), including reflecting on times you have felt worried. Also, complete this week's 'thoughtful' challenge activity.			
<b>Understanding the World</b>	Animals	We will learn about different types of pets and share experiences of having our own pets. Complete some of the 'Animals – Pets' activities provided on Wakelet (Topic and RE), including making models of animals and their habitats, creating a pet collage, and exploring facts about different types of pet.			
<b>Physical</b>	Keeping Active	Join in with a daily physical activity. Choose which one you would like to do from the selection provided on Wakelet (Topic and RE).			

Daily Collective Worship and PSHE/Circle Time Activities will also be planned/taught.
