<b>Week</b>	11	<b>From</b>	29.6.2020	<b>To</b>	3.7.2020
<b>Topic Project</b>	Over the next two week we will learn more about Animals, with the theme of 'Animal Habitats'. I would like you to make a 'Habitat in a Box'. It can be a habitat for an animal that lives somewhere hot or cold. Research where different animals live to help you decide which animal habitat you will create for your project.				
<b>Subject</b>	<b>Focus</b>	<b>Overview of Home Learning Activities</b>			
<b>Reading</b>	Reading Skills	Read for 10-15 minutes every day – keep a note in your reading record. Use one of the reading resources provided on Wakelet (English) or books you have at home.			
<b>Writing</b>	Phonics	Join in with daily phonics lessons on Ruth Miskin's Read Write Inc. YouTube channel (see link of Wakelet – English). Complete one of the follow-up lessons on Word Reading and/or Spelling. Choose Set 1, 2 or 3 depending on ability and level of challenge.			
	Handwriting	See this week's handwriting sheets on Wakelet (English). One sound per day – this week we are focusing on oy, oi, ay, a-e, igh and i-e.			
	Literacy/Writing	Complete this week's lessons and activities all based on 'Animals – Animal Habitats' (see daily lessons on Wakelet – Literacy). These will focus on exploring the homes of different types of animals, writing descriptions of habitats, and sorting and describing animals who live in hot or cold climates.			
<b>Maths</b>	Mental Maths	With a focus on 'Subtraction Facts to 5', spend 10 minutes each day working on a selection of different Mental Maths activities (see Wakelet – Maths).			
	Number or Shape, Space and Measure	Complete this week's lessons and activities all based on 'Length, Height and Distance' (see daily lessons on Wakelet – Maths). Child will learn to use language to describe length and height, make direct comparisons using mathematical vocabulary, and use non-standard units such as blocks to measure.			
<b>RE</b>	Prayer	This week we will continue learning about 'Prayer', showing an understanding that prayer is a special time for people to spend with God. Complete some of the Prayer activities provided on Wakelet (Topic and RE), including recalling prayers they have learnt and to take part in devising prayers of thanks.			
<b>Understanding the World</b>	Animals	We will learn about different types of pets and share experiences of having our own pets. Complete some of the 'Animals – Animal Habitats' activities provided on Wakelet (Topic and RE), including learning about animals who live in hot and cold climates, creating collages of habitats, dancing to African music and creating 'cold' dances to Frozen.			
<b>Physical</b>	Keeping Active	Join in with a daily physical activity. Choose which one you would like to do from the selection provided on Wakelet (Topic and RE).
