

Veni Sancte Spiritus.


Come, Father of the poor,

Amen




Morning Prayer

Amen.




Grace before Meals

Amen




Prayer to Jesus

Amen.




Glory to God in the Highest

### Confiteor


I confess to almighty God

He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead,  
And his kingdom will have no end.

**Hail Mary...**


Behold the handmaid of the Lord

And your word is true.


You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.

Act of Charity


O my God,

Prayer of St Francis of Assisi


Lord, make me an instrument of your peace.

## The Magnificat


My soul glorifies the Lord,

And raises the lowly.


He fills the starving with good things,

**Luke** was a doctor, also known to have written the book of Acts. His day is October 18th.


