Topic Project	This term we are going to be learning all about the Romans. To get your taste for it, over the next two weeks, research the colosseum from Ancient Rome. Discover what it was used for, what it originally looked like and what it is used for now. Did anything famous happen there? Show your findings in any creative way you would like.				
Subject	Focus	Overview of Home Learning Activities			
Reading	Reading Skills	Read for 15 minutes every day – keep a note in your reading record. Complete the reading comprehension task one day this week on Wakelet			
Writing	Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar	See this week's spelling sheet on Wakelet. Write your spellings out in a list and use the Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check method.			
	Handwriting	See this week's handwriting on Wakelet.			
	Text Exploration	Read the next text extract from our book 'Escape from Pompeii'. You may want to do this with an adult in case there are any words you do not fully understand. This week, you will be writing an interview with Tranio and Livia. This will be used next week when you are writing a newspaper report on the events of Pompeii.			
	Planning for Writing	What questions would you ask these characters about what has happened to them? What might their responses be? How can you show the way things were spoken to the interviewer using punctuation? Think about how you would feel and apply this to the characters' responses to you.			
	Writing	Use the model and checklist to write an interview with the characters Tranio and Livia in script like form.			
Maths	Recall Facts	Recall doubling and halving of multiples of 10 up to 200.			
	Fractions	Complete this week's worksheets – available on Wakelet			
RE	Easter	This week we are going to explore the way we share in the risen life of Jesus through Holy Communion and how we can prepare for this celebration.			
Science	Plants	This week you will be looking at what a plant needs in order for it to grow.
