Reading	Reading Skills	Read for 15 minutes every day – keep a note in your reading record. Complete the reading comprehension task one day this week on Wakelet			
Writing	Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar	See this week's spelling sheet on Wakelet. Write your spellings out in a list and use the Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check method.

	Text Exploration	Explore the example of reports on the eruption of the volcano. Pay close attention to the language, tone and important quotes that are used.			
	Planning for Writing	What are the key features of a report? Think carefully about what quotes you want to include from your interview in the newspaper – what will the reader want to know the most?			
	Writing	Use your interview from last week, the (written) model and checklist to write a report of the events of the volcanic eruption. Film yourself delivering the report on a news channel. Send your video to me using Purple Mash.
