Topic Project		Over the next two weeks, research the Abu Simbel Temple. This is a famous temple from Ancient Egypt – what can you find out about it? Use your imagination and express your findings however you like. It could be a poster, a fact file, a piece of art work or even some graffiti – make sure you ask permission first!! You could even design your own Temple!			
Subject	Focus	Overview of Home Learning Activities			
Reading	Reading Skills	Read for 15 minutes every day – keep a note in your reading record. Complete the reading comprehension task one day this week on Wakelet			
	Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar	See this week's spelling sheet on Wakelet. Write your spellings out in a list and use the Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check method.			
Writing	Handwriting	See this week's handwriting on Wakelet.			
	Text Exploration	This week, you will be writing a rhyming poem about the River Nile. Have a look at the example on Wakelet. Look at the different rhyming patterns.			
	Planning for Writing	Think about words that can be used to describe the River Nile. Think about the uses and the importance of the River to the Ancient Egyptians.			
	Writing	Use your ideas to write your rhyming poem.			
Maths	Recall Facts	Recall the 4 times tables – at least 10 minutes.			
	Fractions	Complete this week's worksheets – available on Wakelet			
RE	Holy Week	Look at the significance of 'The Last Supper'. Think about Jesus' actions and his word's. Focus on when he told his friends that one of them was going to betray them.			
Science	Plants	Carry out an experiment to explore the way water travels through a plant. See Wakelet for information and details of the experiment. Record your findings of what happens. Be sure to do the experiment with an adult present.
