Topic Project	This term we are going to be learning all about the Romans. To get your taste for it, over the next two weeks, research the colosseum from Ancient Rome. Discover what it was used for, what it originally looked like and what it is used for now. Did anything famous happen there? Show your findings in any creative way you would like.				
Subject	Focus	Overview of Home Learning Activities			
Reading	Reading Skills	Read for 15 minutes every day – keep a note in your reading record. Complete the reading comprehension task one day this week on Wakelet			
Writing	Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar	See this week's spelling sheet on Wakelet. Write your spellings out in a list and use the Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check method.			
	Handwriting	See this week's handwriting on Wakelet.			
	Text Exploration	Read the text extract from our new book this term 'Escape from Pompeii'. You may want to do this with an adult in case there are any words you do not fully understand. This week, you will be writing a diary entry of the main character.			
	Planning for Writing	Explore what the character does in his everyday life, think about whether he appears to enjoy his life or not based on clues in the text. Who are his friends? Who are his parents? What is happening when the extract stops? What might the character be thinking is happening? What might the character do next?			
	Writing	Use the model and checklist to write a diary extract of the main character. Take words from the text to up-level your descriptions of people and other things around him. Don't forget to keep referring back to the text when writing.			
Maths	Recall Facts	Recall the 8 times tables – at least 10 minutes.			
	Fractions	Complete this week's worksheets – available on Wakelet			
RE	Easter	Read the story of 'The Road to Emmaus'. Rewrite the story as one of the disciples on the road with Jesus. Read the story of 'The Breakfast by the Shore'. Compare the two stories looked at this week.			
Science	Plants	This week you are going to explore the process of photosynthesis in plants. Think about how you get your nutrients – how is this different to a plant?
