I will keep you up to date as plans unfold. Thank you to all those who continue to donate and who support us in making St. Mary's the best that we can for your children.

As we move through Lent, and the children are preparing for Easter, we have a whole school Lenten Promise this year which is to say The Angelus everyday in class in addition to our daily prayers. The Angelus is traditionally prayed at 12noon and 6pm. There is a copy of the prayer in the Newsletter and we invite you to say The Angelus at home in the evening with your children so that you too can share in their Lenten journey.
