beside quiet waters.'

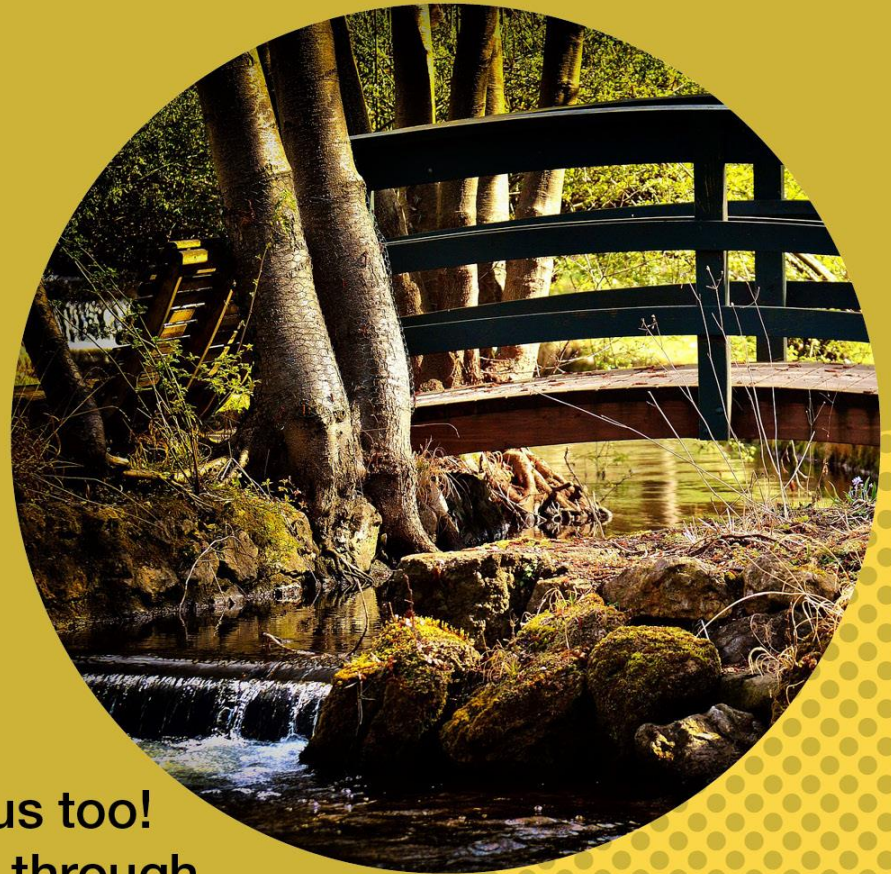
Psalm 23
