**Saturday**

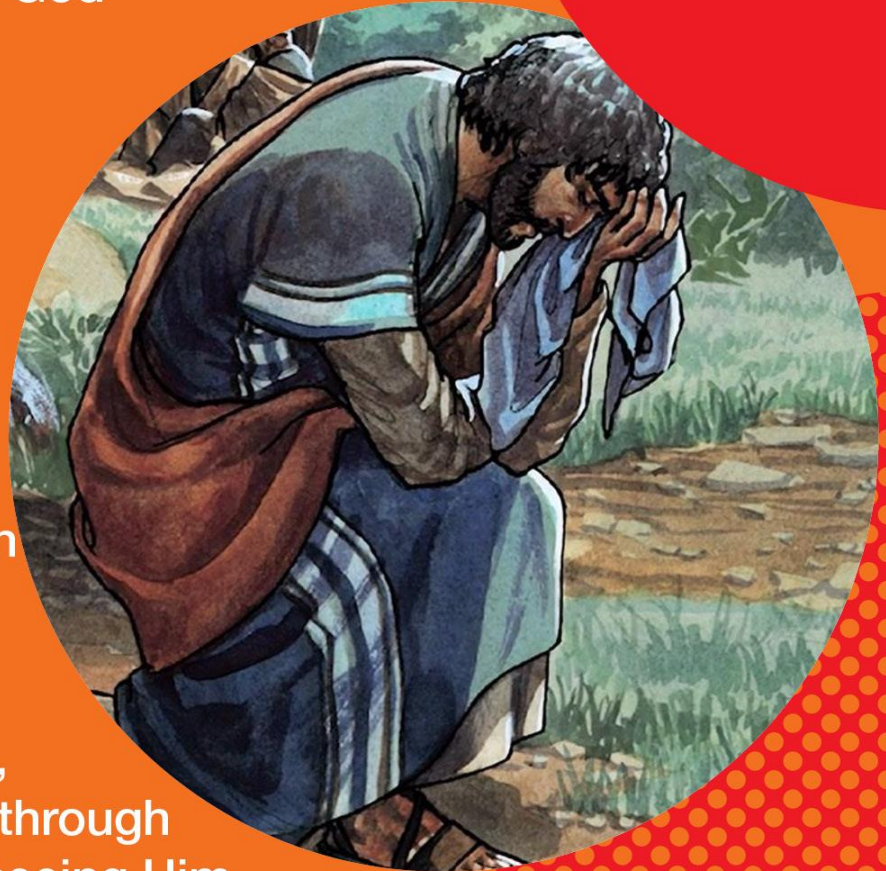
**Prayer Leader:**

In the Gospel this week, Jesus prays to God with the disciples nearby.

He says to God, “All I have is yours, and all you have is mine. And in them I am glorified.”

Just think about that again for a moment: Jesus was glorified through His disciples. They saw Jesus for who He was, were glad about it, and acted in ways that showed everyone how important Jesus was to them.

We didn't do anything to make God big, or valuable or beautiful: He just is! But, through knowing Jesus, we can glorify God by seeing Him for what He is, by being glad that He is that way and then by acting and speaking in a way that shows other people who we see and love.



**Prayer Leader:**

Remember that 'glorify' means to worship God like we know how important He is. So let's ask ourselves:
