Thank you for your support during our staggered arrival and dismissal times so far this term.

As part of our continual review of all COVID-19 restrictions and processes, we have evaluated the arrival and dismissal elements of the school day.

From Monday 28th September 2020, the staggered arrival and dismissal times will be as follows:

Year Group	Arrival	Dismissal
Pre-School, Reception & Year 1	8:35	2:50
Years 2, 5 & 6	8:35	2:50
Years 3 & 4	8:45	2:55

In the morning, the gates will close at 8:50am and in the afternoon they will close at 3:05pm. No changes have been made to your drop of and collection points.

I'd like to remind parents and carers that it is absolutely integral to maintain social distancing between yourself and the next parent/carer. When entering the playground, please remain in a socially-distanced line and avoid, wherever possible, doubling up or crowding into the space. I thank you for your support in this, to keep our school community as safe as possible. If you wish to wear a mask whilst dropping off or collecting children, you are most welcome to do so.
