

KS1 Maths (Year 1 & Year 2)

Position Puzzles

Challenge your children to move the shape cards around to match the description. This activity is great for developing their reasoning skills and use of positional language. There is a harder version to tackle once they've cracked the first one!

Multiple Mazes (x2, x3, x5, x10)

Help your child to become familiar with the multiples in the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times table.

Top tip: pop the sheet into a clear plastic folder and challenge children to complete the maze using a dry wipe pen. The sheet can then be wiped off so the activity can be repeated.

Numbers Wordsearch

Help your child learn how to spell numbers by challenging them to find them in these three differentiated numbers wordsearches.

KS1 Numbers Crossword

These two tricky crosswords will challenge your child to complete number sentences to fill out the crossword. When they've finished, why not challenge them to create their own version using squared paper?

Colour by Number Addition

This fun colouring activity will help with recall of simple addition facts. There are three different versions which increase in challenge.

Colour by Number Subtraction

Completing this activity will help your child to recall subtraction facts...and they reveal fun pictures once they're finished!

Find the Number Sentence

Each of these Find the Number Sentence Cards will help your child become more familiar with the different ways numbers can be added to reach a target number. Once they've finished, why not give them a number and see how many addition and subtraction sentences they can come up with to reach that number?

What Time is it, Mr Wolf?

This board game is a great way to familiarise your child with telling the time on an analogue clock. There are plenty of versions for you to play with your child (or for siblings to play in pairs) depending on how confident they already are with reading a clock face.
