Draw a picture of his facial expression below.

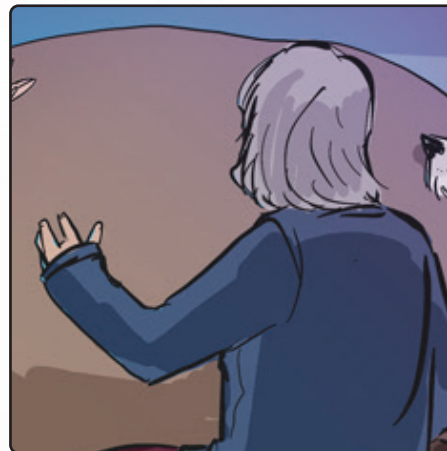
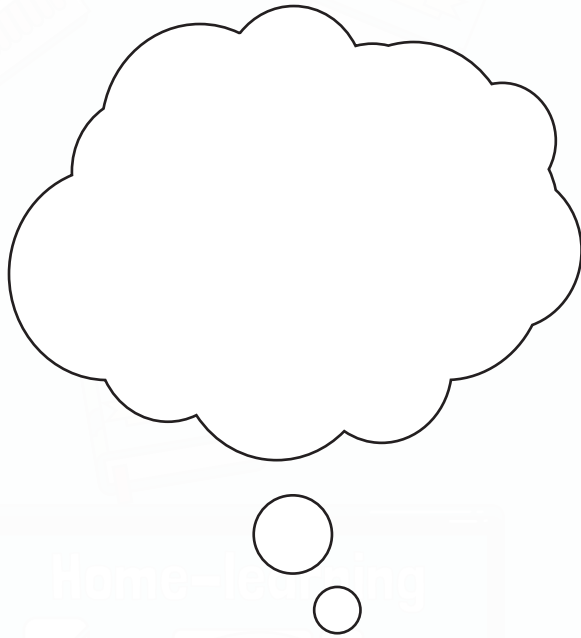


What might the characters be saying to each other?
