	Writing	1 - Write an invitation for a celebration. This could be a birthday party, Easter celebration etc. 2 - Create a list of all of the celebration days you can recall and write a sentence about what you remember about each. 3 - Invent a story involving a celebration. You could write it out or make a story map. Encourage your child to use story language. 4 - Create a birthday card for the next family member's birthday. Try and add a rhyming poem in the middle. 5 - Write a menu for a special celebration. It could be Christmas dinner or a Diwali feast.			
Maths	Recall Facts	Practise your 3 times table every day – at least 10 minutes. Please also practise the reverse operation. E.g. $3 \times 3 = 6$ or 6 divided by $3 = 2$
