	Writing	1 – read the chapters, 2 – answer the questions based on the chapters, 3 – missing words for each chapter, 4 – joining words for each chapter, 5 – Re-cap all three chapters of the story so far. Re – write your own version of the story. Can you change the characters? The setting? Etc.			
Maths	Recall Facts	Practise your 7 times table every day – at least 10 minutes. Please also practise the reverse operation. E.g. $3 \times 7 = 21$ <u>or</u> $21$ divided by $7 = 3$
