Subject	Focus	Overview of Home Learning Activities			
Reading	Reading Skills	Read for 15 minutes every day – keep a note in your reading record.			
Writing	Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar	See this week's spelling sheet on Wakelet. Write your spellings out in a list and use the Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check method.			
	Handwriting	See this week's handwriting on Wakelet.			
	Text Exploration	See the daily tasks on Wakelet relating to <i>Clockwork</i> .			
	Planning for Writing	Look at the daily tasks on Wakelet to help support your writing – you will be considering both sides of Karl's character in order for your writing task.			
	Writing	At the end of the week you will be asked to write a balanced argument about whether Karl deserved to die. Check Wakelet for guidance!			
Maths	Recall Facts	Practise your 7x table, including the inverse (e.g. $__ \times 5 = 35$, $7 \times __ = 49$)			
	Fractions Consolidation	Complete this week's activities – available on Wakelet daily.			
RE	Holy Week	Create a "Holy Week Web". Recall names of people, places and events that took place during this week. Look at the map of the Holy Land and trace the journey of Jesus from Bethany to Jerusalem on Palm Sunday.			
Science	Friction	Investigate Friction by testing out toys on different surfaces around your home. Check Wakelet for more guidance and worksheets.
