I hope that by now your children have settled into the routine of the new school year at St Mary's and that they are getting to know their teachers.

Your child may have mentioned, or may mention in future, that sometimes they have been taught by a different teacher. This is because all class teachers are entitled to time away from the classroom for planning, preparation and assessment (PPA time). During this time your child will be taught by Mr Millett who covers PPA throughout the school. On other occasions your child's class teacher may be ill or called to attend a course and a supply teacher (who is a very experienced teacher and known to St Mary's) may cover the class. By employing teachers known to St Mary's we strive to keep changes to a minimum for yourself and your child.

Attendance For the Academic Year 2010-2011

Our overall attendance for 2010-2011 was 95.74%

It is really pleasing to see that a great percentage of our pupils attend for at least 95% of the time which is the government national target for attendance. Absences have a major impact on progress. For example one week's absence equates to a child missing about 25 lessons. Understandably sometimes absences are unavoidable through sickness but we would urge that all parents ensure that their child attends as frequently as possible so that they make good progress in their learning.

As a school we have a statutory duty to ensure that we enable all children in our care to make as much progress as they should. This is the reason why we cannot authorise any other absence apart from illness which is unavoidable. It is crucial that 'parents, carers and pupils understand that attendance and punctuality are important' (Ofsted)
