

Home Learning Plan

The table below outlines the planned weekly coverage for your child. Each day your child's teacher will share learning activities and supporting resources on Wakelet (<https://wakelet.com/>) Links to individual classes pages can be found on the inside cover of children's books or on the school website. These activities will need to be completed in your child's home learning book which they will be required to bring back to school once it reopens. If your child has been absent from school and so has not received their book, or if the exercise book is completed, then any paper or alternative book can be used. Topic Project	Over the next two weeks, keep a record of daily weather patterns. Try and get outside and focus on some adjectives that describe what the weather is like. You can use this to create some artwork, poems and weather reports about the different types of weather you see. You may decide to use technology to record yourself giving a daily weather report like on the news! There will be other resources available on Wakelet and Purple Mash. You may decide to do PE with Joe Wicks at 9.am every morning outside. You could write a journal of what you have been doing on days where it is sunny and how that is different to what you would be doing if it is raining or cold.				
Subject	Focus	Overview of Home Learning Activities			
Reading	Reading Skills	Read for at least 15 minutes every day – keep a note in your reading record.			
Writing	Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar	See this week's spelling sheet on Wakelet. Write your spellings out in a list and use the Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check method. There is also the normal spellings word search. You may ask your grown up to test you on these like we normally do on a Wednesday!			
	Handwriting	See this week's handwriting on Wakelet. There is also a handwriting section on Purple Mash.			
	Text Exploration	This week, you will be looking at reading comprehension.			
	Phonics	Practice your speed sounds, green words and alien words on Wakelet. Practice your common exception words. Complete work on Wakelet.			
	Writing	Write a daily journal of what you have been doing during the day. Think about how the weather links to this- would you be doing something different if it was snowing or raining? Remember to use capital letters, punctuation, finger spaces! There will be other resources available for writing on Wakelet.			
Maths	Recall Facts	Practise your 5 times table every day – at least 10 minutes. Have a go at the times table quizzes set on Purple Mash.			
	Measurement- Weight and volume	Complete this week's worksheets – available on Wakelet with a PDF PowerPoint to support. There will also be optional practical activities available.			

RE	Holy Week	Recall knowledge of Holy week- create a poster/ mindmap/ video etc of what you already know from last year about the events of holy week in the life of Jesus. Work on Wakelet based around Palm Sunday. You could have a go at making your own Palm leaves.
Science	My body	Senses- make a smell/ taste test for someone in your family. Play eye-spy. Create a feely bag and describe/ guess what you can feel. There is more work around this on Wakelet and Purple Mash.
