

**Home Learning Plan**

The table below outlines the planned weekly coverage for your child. Each day your child's teacher will share learning activities and supporting resources on Wakelet (<https://wakelet.com/>) Links to individual classes pages can be found on the inside cover of children's books or on the school website. These activities will need to be completed in your child's home learning book which they will be required to bring back to school once it reopens. <b>Topic Project</b>	Over the next two weeks, you will be focusing on our new topic 'colour creations' which is all about discovering what happens when we mix colours! You may (with your adult's permission and supervision) decide to do this practically with paint. If this is not possible then there will be videos and other links on Wakelet, so you will still be able to see how colours can change. Research task: What are the primary colours? What are secondary colours?				
<b>Subject</b>	<b>Focus</b>	<b>Overview of Home Learning Activities</b>			
<b>Reading</b>	Reading Skills	Read for at least 15 minutes every day – keep a note in your reading record.			
<b>Writing</b>	Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar	See this week's spelling sheet on Wakelet. Write your spellings out in a list and use the Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check method. There is also the normal spellings word search. You may ask your grown up to test you on these like we normally do on a Wednesday!			
	Handwriting	See this week's handwriting on Wakelet. There is also a handwriting section on Purple Mash.			
	Text Exploration	This week, you will be looking at reading comprehension.			
	Phonics	Practice your speed sounds, green words and alien words on Wakelet. Practice your common exception words. Complete work on Wakelet.			
	Writing	This week your writing activities will link to the RE set. This will include retelling key stories, writing prayers, writing a diary of the thoughts of a character and making an ID card for Jesus.			
<b>Maths</b>	Recall Facts	Practise your 10 times table every day – at least 10 minutes. Have a go at the times table quizzes set on Purple Mash.			
	Measurement- Weight and volume	Complete this week's worksheets – available on Wakelet with a PDF PowerPoint to support. There will also be optional practical activities available.			
<b>RE</b>	Holy Week	This week we will be looking at what Jesus said and did at the Last Supper table. We will also learn the story of Jesus carrying the cross and think about how this can help Christians follow Jesus today.
