Thank you to everyone who gave generously on Mufti day. We managed to raise £146.00 towards Hollie's new wheelchair. Hollie's new chair has many features which are bespoke to Hollie's needs, some of the features include a tilting riser both forward and backwards. The forward tilt allows Hollie to be able to self serve at a counter rather than being in a upright vertical position and the reclining position allows her to do her physio on her legs whilst in a supportive seating position. Other fantastic features include headlights and indicators for evenings out as she grows older and gains independence and a charging point and holder for her mobile phone. She has a removable tray, so if having a difficult day at school, she can stay in her chair and use IT equipment whilst being fully supported. All these features are bespoke to Hollie and will not be found on a NHS prescription wheelchair!

Congratulations to all of our swimmers this year! It is so wonderful to see that you have represented St Mary's so well and have been recognised for your fantastic behaviour!



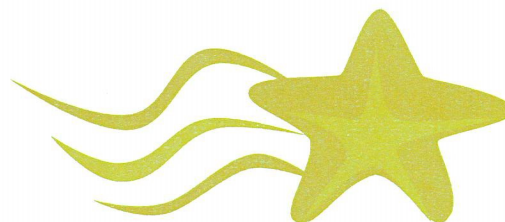
