Ofsted Inspection

As you know, Ofsted inspectors visited St. Mary's on October 18th and 19th and were very pleased with our school. Their letter to the children is attached with this newsletter and the report is now available to read on www.ofsted.gov.uk. Our school URN is 103843.

I am sure that you will agree that the report is very positive and we are delighted that our provision is good with outstanding features. However, we are disappointed that the inspectors judged attendance as only satisfactory since many of our pupils have excellent attendance. Unfortunately, because of the number of children who miss school due to holidays in term time, and who therefore miss many lessons, our overall school attendance rate could not be judged as good. You will see that the inspectors have made reference to this is their letter to the children. Nevertheless, we will continue striving to improve all aspects of our provision at St. Mary's and I would like to take this opportunity to thank all parents, staff, governors, friends of the school, Fr Darley and members of our parishes for your continued support which enables us to work together in partnership for the benefit of all children at St. Mary's school.

RE Inspection

Our RE Inspection dates are November 21st and 22nd and the inspection will be undertaken by Fr Michael Doleman.

I am sure that he will be just as impressed by the children as the Ofsted inspectors were.
