### Dear Parent/Carer,

## IS YOUR CHILD ELIGIBLE FOR FREE SCHOOL MEALS?

The Government provides extra money to schools to help children from lower incomes to do their very best. This funding is called the Pupil Premium and if your child is registered, school gets an extra £1320 which is used to enrich your child's education.

Although Foundation and KS1 pupils receive Universal Free School Meals, it is important that you apply for Free School meals if your family circumstances fit the following criteria.

If you get any of the following support payments your child may be entitled to receive free school meals:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit Run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit

#### Please note:

 If your child is in Reception, years one or two, you will automatically be entitled for free meals under the new 'Universal Infant Free School Meals' criteria. However if you do meet the criteria listed above then you will need to submit an on-line claim in order for your child's school to receive Pupil Premium funding.

If you are unsure about your eligibility for Free School Meals, please call 01384 814988. There will be someone on hand to answer any of your queries. In order for your child to benefit from this extra funding it is important that children are on the register for Free School Meals as **soon as possible** to release the school funding.
