	Writing	Answer the questions that have been set on Purple Mash. Using Purple Mash complete the 'Elephant Rides' work that has been set. Debate writing and explaining this to parents/carers			
Maths	Recall Facts	Practise your all of your times tables every day including the inverse – at least 10 minutes. Purple Mash – multiplication check practice – 3 times a week Times Table Rock Stars – logins emailed to the children via Purple Mash
